

LEGAL STATUS

There are now three separate cases pending in the Litchfield District Superior Court, all of which are before Judge Moore.

(1) Adams v. Vail This is the original case that was filed as a nuisance action against the track in the late fifties. Last September, the track filed a Motion in this case to allow greatly expanded racing, camping and traffic in and out of the track. LRCC filed a Motion asking the court to stay proceedings in this case and, thus, send it to the Salisbury Planning and Zoning Commission ("P&Z"). This was briefed and argued on June 2d and is now awaiting decision by Judge Moore.

(2) Track's Appeal of the Zoning Board of Appeals' Order limiting camping in accordance with the existing rules. The Track appealed that Order. This case was also briefed and argued on June 2d and is awaiting decision by Judge Moore.

(3) Track's Appeal of The P&Z's adoption of it's Revised Regulations governing the track. In this case, the track attacks the validity of the P&Z Revised Regulations. It is scheduled for briefing and argument in September.

It is likely that any decision by Judge Moore adverse to the track will be appealed by it to the Connecticut Appellate Court.
